## MORATORIUM NOTICE

Contrary to popular opinion, the Vietnam Moratorium is alive and well. And about to kick again.

At the last Moratorium meeting the fact that Vice-President Agnew is coming to DesMoines was brought up. He will be speaking at the Veteran's Memorial Auditorium on April 13. Various methods of meeting this assault were contemplated, and the following plans were voted upon and adapted.

- I. A three day march from Grinnell to Des Moines, to evidence to Agnew our dissatisfaction with Administration policy and his own statements in public concerning dissent and protest. All Grinnell students are invited to join us in this march. The marchers will be accommodated by local citizens in Newton and Mitchelville for the 2 nights. Programs and dialogues with townspeople have been scheduled for each evening.
- II. To supply chartered transportation to and from Des Moines on Monday, 13 April for as many people as wish to join us in confronting Agnew.

In addition to these actions, the Vietnam Moratorium is sponsoring a program of worker education in Grinnell, beginning with the distribution of information to factory workers on Friday, 10 April. We are seriously understaffed for this at the moment, and any and all volunteers will be heartily welcomed.

The next meeting of the Moratorium Committee is on Tuesday, April 7. All members of the Grinnell community are invited and welcomed. The meeting is at 10.00 P.M. in Gardner Lounge.
