Our government has been unresponsive to our needs for abortion, safe birth control, day-care centers and job equality. Women, as well as anti-war protesters, must recognize that the Government is not concerned about our needs.

White males are responsible for our presence in Vietnam and Cambodia; white males are responsible for our Panther sisters being kept political prisoners in New Haven; they are the same white males who deny us the freedom to control our own bodies and minds and lives.

We must unite with our sisters, in Iowa, North Vietnam, Cambodia, New Haven...everywhere!

We are making placards with slogans such as "Solidarity With Our Sisters in Vietnam!", "Free our Sisters in New Haven!", "Sisters Unite!" and so on. We urge you to bring signs of your own - banners and flags too!
