RESOLUTIONS PASS WEDNESDAY NIGHT, FEB. 12, 1969, BY GRINNELL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE

Re attorney general's investigation:

As both the implications and results of such an investigation are possibly detrimental to the college, its ideals, and goals, we not only remind members of the college community, but encourage them to exercise their respective privileges to withhold information from the representatives of the attorney general unless subpoenaed.

Re letter sent by the deans of students to parents of disrobing students on Feb. 10:

We seriously question the conduct of the deans' office in handling the matter. We believe the action to be discriminatory, arbitrary, and contrary to accepted administration practice. The Grinnell College Student Senate respectfully requests that the student-faculty Judicial Council consider the following:

1. The action of the deans described above.
2. Existing college guidelines for administration-parent contact concerning individual students.
3. The possibility of clarification and/or extension of these guidelines.
